WHO MAY PARTICIPATE:

SOCCA's 2010 Spring and Fall program is open to boys and girls born in 2004 through 5th Grade and 6th through 12 Grades for the Spring season only. 2010 Girls and Boys 6th Grade participants may try out for the Junior High level Travel teams that play in the Fall. In our program, we stress recreation, team atmosphere, good sportsmanship, equal participation and fun. We are a recreational league and games are conducted on a non-competitive basis as we do not keep score or team standings. Travel Teams are on a Jr. High competitive level playing other clubs and schools.

FEES:

SOCCA has been fortunate to receive financial support from McDonald's of Coshocton and Newcomerstown to help defray costs. The fee, which will cover both the spring and fall sessions, is \$40.00 per player with a maximum of \$80.00 per family. The registration fee covers 6 games in the spring and 6 games in the fall, shirt, socks, fields, officials, and other operational fees. Players that are not eligible for the fall session, (6th grade through 12th grade only) pay \$20. 6th grade through 12th grade play 6 games in spring only. Travel Team fees are not included here.

WHERE SOCCER IS PLAYED:

All games will be held on Saturdays at the Lake Park Soccer complex. Once teams are established, players will be contacted by their coaches, who will determine where and when practice will be held. Players must wear shin guards and tennis shoes or cleats that have no toe cleat.

HOW TEAMS ARE FORMED:

Every effort is made to make teams as balanced as possible. Factors considered in team formation include: age, grade level, and school, years of soccer experience, and number of players per team as well as the number of teams that can be formed. ***Requests to place siblings on the same team should be written clearly on the registration form. In circumstances where the siblings are requested on the same team and the children are of different ages, the younger child will be asked to play up on the older age level team.*** SOCCA reserves the right to restrict late entries, if the number of applicants exceeds that which can be competently and efficiently managed.
